IDEAS

COLOR GUARD MEMBERS:

- Wearing the Queen costume and serving as the chess characters.
- Using the CG as a general chess look and not being too specific with specific chess pieces, as most color guards will have different sizes of ensemble.
- If you have a strong soloist performer, you could highlight them as the "Queen" and utilize a crown on their head as you use them for solo virtuoistic moments.

MUSICIANS:

- Wearing traditional band costume OR suggested band top.
- Colors for optional band top can be adapted easily.

- CHESS FLAT PROPS:
 - Utilizing various flats to showcase chess
 - Frames/flats can be moved through the perimeter as a backdrop.

 - Be mindful of wind and outdoor conditions that can make using tarps challenging.
 - You will likely need to weigh down the edges with small weighted bars to hold it down during windy days.
 - PULLOVER: "CHECKMATE" -- could be used at the very end of the show!

IDEAS FOR DRILL WRITER

PART 1: Introduction of the Chess Pieces

VISUAL:

Listen to the narration and try to interpret each chess piece description through the use of drill, staging, and choreography. Featuring small vignettes of color guard dancers or flags with each small featured group of musicians to lead our eye through the experience.

All color guard will be on flag by M37 so that we can do a full color field moment by M43. We will want to feature one color guard soloist with a crown on her head the could even have a special "Queen" flag" to highlight her and establish her character.
