IDEAS FOR DRILL WRITER

PART 1: Establish Jester Character

VISUAL:
CG performers emerge from the "?" box gradually to take over the field. Use movement choreography to set the stage and define the mischievous character. All 6 foot flags are preset lines for first big impact moment.

Color Guard will spin 6 foot flags. Split color guard into groups to p o the voices in the musical soundscape.

Use the whirlwind music weaving in and out of the Valkyries theme character. Valkyries theme sounds so serious and majest have the sh the jester ition of the other musical lines to counter with whimsy and mischief.

Use the final section of Part 1 to create an event lead ie s causes mayhem (use the list provided to choose some ideas)
